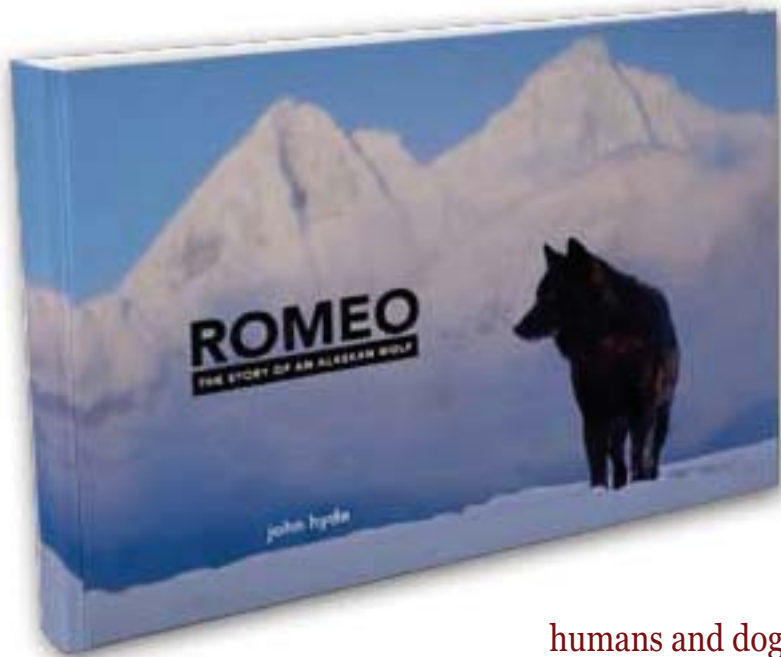

Set in the glaciers of Alaska, *Romeo: The Story of an Alaskan Wolf* (Bunker Hill Publishing; available: October 2010) is the true account of an American urban legend. Orphaned and alone, a black wolf has made the Mendenhall Glacier outside of Juneau his territory for the past decade, subsisting on a diet of small mammals and fish. Unafraid of tourists and locals and eager to bond with his canine cousins, the wolf, nicknamed Romeo, wins the hearts of humans and dogs alike with his gentle, playful nature. Through breathtaking photographs of the Alaskan wilderness and telling written detail, writer/photographer John Hyde has turned this unbelievable story into a tour de force.

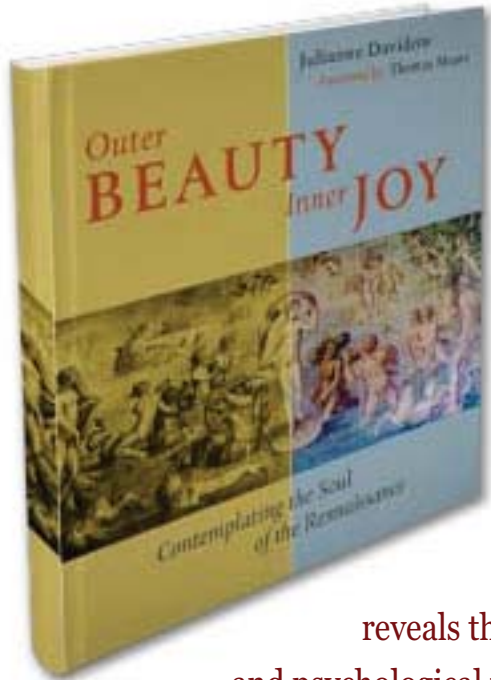

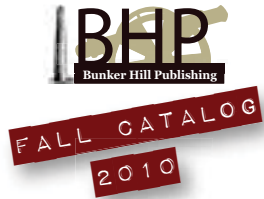

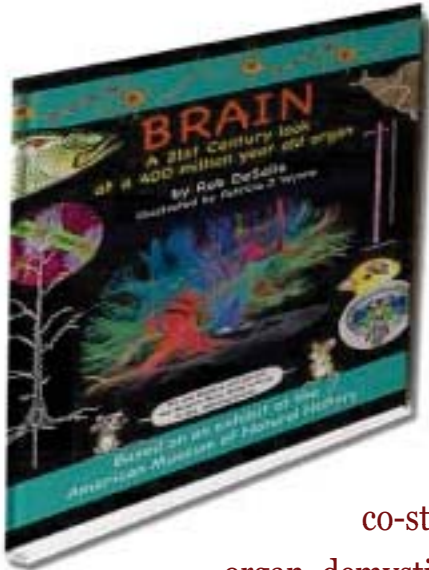

Brain: A 21st Century Look at a 400 Million Year Old Organ is the companion volume to the highly acclaimed Bones, Brains and DNA, and is based on a new exhibit at the American Museum of Natural History that opens November 3rd, 2010.

Brain simplifies and explains major concepts that will help young readers understand the complex makeup and function of the brain. Complicated topics like the structure of neural cells, the function of synapses, and the chemical nature of how nerves work are broken down in easy-to-read sections, helped along with witty commentary from its duo of rodent co-stars. This lavishly illustrated book takes readers on a guided tour of science's most important organ, demystifying the processes of sleep, vision, and memory, among others.
